# Survey Notes

These results are from a Saint Anselm College Survey Center poll based on online surveys of 1491 New Hampshire registered voters. Surveys were collected between March 16<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>, 2026, from cell phone users randomly drawn from a sample of registered voters reflecting the demographic and partisan characteristics of the voting population. Names were presented in random order for the favorability and ballot tests. The survey has an overall margin of sampling error of +/- 2.5% with a confidence interval of 95%. The data are weighted for age, gender, geography, education, and 2024 presidential vote based on a voter demographic model derived from historical voting patterns, but are not weighted by party registration or party identification.



# Summary of Findings

New Hampshire Institute of Politics Executive Director Neil Levesque summarized the results, saying, “War and economic uncertainty tend to hurt the incumbent party. As a result, the political environment continues to deteriorate for New Hampshire Republicans, putting Congressman Chris Pappas in a more favorable position than in our previous survey. However, Governor Kelly Ayotte bests two potential opponents in head-to-head matchups despite a slight decline in popularity. California Governor Gavin Newsom’s New Hampshire Primary support has declined significantly, leaving former Transportation Secretary Pete Buttigieg as the early frontrunner. New Hampshire voters are significantly opposed to a state income tax.”


- **The U.S. military action in Iran is unpopular.** Just 40% of New Hampshire voters approve while 59% disapprove. Democratic voter opposition is nearly unanimous at 96%, while a significant number (20%) of Republican voters are also opposed.
- **The Democratic Party is now more trusted on economic issues.** A slight plurality (41%-40%) trusts the Democratic Party over the Republican Party, a reversal from November when the Republican Party led on this question by seven points, 44%-37%. The Democratic Party has also improved its trust advantage on affordability issues and now enjoys a seven-point edge, 44%-37%.
- **Turmoil is creating political headwinds for Republicans.** The Democratic lead on the generic ballot has opened up to eight points, 49%-41%, up from 46%-42% in November.
- **Voter opposition to a state income tax remains significant.** 71% are opposed to implementation of a state income tax, including a plurality (47%-43%) of registered Democrats.
- **Elections/Democracy continues to be the top voter concern.** This is the top pick of 26% of voters overall, and 41% of registered Democrats. Affordability has overtaken Economy/Inflation as the next top concern (15%), emphasizing the issues advantage enjoyed by the Democratic Party.
- **President Donald Trump’s job approval and popularity remain steady.** 58% of New Hampshire voters disapprove of the job Trump is doing, matched by 58% that have an unfavorable opinion of the President. This is negligibly worse than in November, when he was at 57% disapproval and 57% unfavorable.
- **Democratic voters maintain their enthusiasm gap.** 96% are “extremely likely” to vote in the upcoming general election, compared to 88% of Republicans.

- **Governor Kelly Ayotte maintains a slim plurality on her job approval.** 49% of voters approve of the job Ayotte is doing versus 47% who disapprove. This represents a slight deterioration since November, when she was at 49%-43%.
- **Neither of Ayotte's potential opponents are particularly well-known, giving her an early advantage in her re-election campaign.** 53% of voters have no opinion of repeat contender Cinde Warmington, while 80% have no opinion first-time candidate Jon Kiper. Ayotte leads in a matchup against Warmington, 46%-39%, and against Kiper, 45%-31%. Warmington leads the Democratic gubernatorial primary election, 40%-13%.
- **Congressman Chris Pappas enjoys leads against both potential opponents despite declining popularity.** Pappas' favorability is now tied at 46%-46%. He maintains leads against former Senators John E. Sununu (46%-43%) and Scott Brown (47%-38%). Sununu leads Brown in the Republican Senate primary election, 49%-28%.
- **Freshman Congresswoman Maggie Goodlander's has restored her lead in a potential repeat matchup against Lily Tang Williams.** Political headwinds have impacted Williams, as she is now upside-down (32%-33%) on her favorability. Goodlander now enjoys a 48%-36% lead over Williams in her re-election bid.
- **2020 second-place finisher Pete Buttigieg continues to be the early favorite in the New Hampshire Democratic Presidential Primary as California Governor Gavin Newsom falls back to the pack.** 29% of Democratic voters would vote for Buttigieg if the primary election were held today, followed by 15% for Newsom and 10% for Congresswoman Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez. Former Vice President Kamala Harris enjoys the support of only 6% of New Hampshire Democrats.
- **Vice President J.D. Vance remains the early Presidential choice of New Hampshire Republicans, although support for Secretary of State Marco Rubio has grown significantly.** Vance has the support of 46% of Republican voters, down from 57% in November. Rubio has tripled his support from 9% to 27%, and must now be considered a significant potential challenger to Vance.




### Democratic Gubernatorial Primary




### Republican Senate Primary




### Governor: Ayotte vs. Kiper




### Governor: Ayotte vs. Warmington




### Senate General: Pappas Vs. Brown




