The American Lung Association in New Hampshire's COPD Educator Institute provides healthcare professionals with a thorough overview of COPD information. The course will include practical information healthcare providers can use in their work with patients living with COPD. Specific attention will be given to tobacco treatment, spirometry, disease management, medication guidelines, end of life issues, the role of pulmonary rehabilitation, oxygen therapy and patient education.

- Pulmonary Rehabilitation: Self Management and Monthly Support Groups

At the end of the program, participants will be able to:

- Analyze the components of COPD education: lung pathophysiology, assessment of physical status, environmental factors, barriers to self care and pharmacological interventions.
- Design COPD management and education plans for individuals in a variety of situations.
- Teach individuals how to manage their COPD using appropriate devices and techniques.
