DIRECTIONS FOR POSTER ABSTRACT SUBMISSION:

- Please include the following in your submission under separate headings:
 - Title of Project
 - Type of Project: Indicate if your poster will present Qualitative Research, Quantitative Research, an Educational project, a Clinical Practice project, or other type of project described.
 - Project summary: Provide a brief summary of the project including background, outcomes, and recommendations.
 - Poster attendee outcomes: Provide an explanation on how your abstract submission relates to the conference focus (see title above).
- Limit the abstract to one page with a font size no less than 12.
- List author, credentials, and affiliation. NOTE: author information will be blinded for submission review
- Include a cover with one author as the contact person. Include the contact person's address, phone number, and email address.

POSTER DETAILS:

- No larger than 3 ft x 4 ft. (size of trifold poster board)
- Posters will be on display during the conference on Thursday, September 12, 2019.
- An author must be present during poster exhibit hours of 5-6PM.
