DIRECTIONS FOR POSTER ABSTRACTS:

The content of each abstract must be organized under separate headings according to one of the following formats: The **traditional research** format, the **qualitative research** format, or the **education project** format. - Limit the abstract to one page with a font size no less than 12.
- **List author, credentials, and affiliation on this copy.** Abstract without author information will be used for blind review.
- Indicate on THE COVER LETTER one author as the contact person. Include the contact person's address, phone number, and e-mail address.
- Please explain how your poster submission relates to the conference focus.
- Only abstracts following guidelines will be considered.

POSTER DETAILS:

- No larger than 4 ft x 4 ft.
- Posters will be on display during poster session exhibit hours of 4-6 p.m. on Thursday, May 31, 2018.
- An author must be present during poster exhibit hours of 4-6 p.m.
