ABOUT THE ASTHMA EDUCATOR INSTITUTE

The American Lung Association developed the Asthma Educator Institute (AEI), a two-day preparatory course for the National Asthma Education Certification Board (NAECB) exam. The curriculum reflects the detailed content outline delineated in the NAECB Certified Asthma Educator candidate book (see NAECB.com for details). AEI includes hands-on skills, demonstration and practice to increase knowledge and skills.

Who Should Attend?

Respiratory therapists, nurses and other health care professionals with a keen interest in developing skills as an asthma educator and/or in preparing for the NAE exam. Licensed or credentialed health care professionals or individuals with 1,000 hours experience in asthma education, counseling or coordination of services are eligible to take the exam.

- Asthma Overview: Definition, pathophysiology and role of inflammation
- Factors Contributing to Asthma Exacerbations: Allergens, irritants and environment factors
- Patient history and physical assessment
- Case studies using spirometry
- Tobacco treatment in New Hampshire

- Barriers to adherence and compliance
- Asthma Action Plan: Management plan development
- Your role as an asthma educator
- NAECB exam preparation

COURSE GOALS

At the end of the program, participants will be able to:

- Analyze the components of asthma education: lung pathophysiology, assessment of physical status, environmental factors, barriers to adherence and pharmacological interventions.
- Design asthma management and education plans for individuals in a variety of situations.
- Teach individuals how to manage their asthma using appropriate devices and techniques.
- Pursue national certification through NAECB.
