Spectacularly situated on the rock promontory overlooking the Atlantic Ocean and the mouth of the Kennebunk River, it has a heated salt-water swimming pool, private, safe, surf beach, and gorgeous organic gardens. It's located within walking distance (1 mile) of the charming village of Kennebunkport.

HOTEL INFORMATION: A block of overnight rooms have been reserved at the special conference rate of \$105 garden side and \$155 ocean side per night plus tax; includes a full breakfast.
