Saint Anselm College - Department of Nursing Admission for Internal Transfer Policy

Policy:

A student may seek to transfer into the Nursing Program from another major within the College. However, the number of nursing students in each class is limited; therefore very few openings are available.

Procedure:

A student seeking to transfer into the Nursing Program should:

- 1. Complete a Transfer Request Form
- 2. Meet with the Executive Director of the Department of Nursing to discuss the required nursing course sequence and the likelihood that there will be openings in the nursing class
- 3. The Executive Director will consult with the Office of Admissions to ensure that the transfer candidate meets the criteria for admission into the nursing program
- 4. A CGPA of 3.0 is required for transfer consideration
- 5. If accepted, complete a Change of Major Form
- 6. The student must enter the nursing sequence in the spring semester for the first nursing course, *Introduction to Professional Nursing* (NU110)
