Frequently Asked Questions Regarding the Anselmian Aid Portal

What is Anselmian Aid?

Anselmian Aid is a web-based secure financial aid portal for Saint Anselm College students (both prospective and enrolled) to view various components of their financial aid application. It includes: the financial aid offered, all required documents and their status, as well as important messages.

How do I access Anselmian Aid?

Prospective students sign into financialaid.anselm.edu with their Saint Anselm ID as their userid and date of birth MMDDYY as their password. Current students access the Anselmian Aid portal via their MyAnselm portal.

When will I see my financial aid offer?

- **Incoming Students**: If all documents have been received, we will work diligently to review incoming students in a timely fashion so that you can have a financial aid offer before making your decision to enroll by May 1. Once your financial aid application is ready to review and package, we will email and mail you a copy of that offer. You will then be able to view the award on Anselmian Aid.
- **Returning Students**: With the exception of students with special circumstances (in family crisis, planning to study abroad in the fall, or students whose siblings are incoming students), we begin reviewing and awarding enrolled students after the incoming students in May. This year with few exceptions, we are going to send you an email notifying you to go to MyAnselm and review your financial aid offer.

Why can't I see my merit scholarship offered by the Office of Admission?

Students will not be able to see any aid (including merit) offered if their financial aid file is incomplete. Please go to the documents tab to see if we do not have critical documents.

Non-Aid Applicants: If you do not plan to apply for need-based financial aid, we ask you to send us an email indicating you wish us to close your financial aid file. You will then be able to see your merit and/or non-need based aid.
