Transitions is a FREE program that was designed to strengthen the academic, social, and cultural experiences of first year students. It is particularly relevant for students from traditionally underrepresented (commuter, first-generation, multicultural & international) groups but students from **ALL** backgrounds are encouraged to participate.

Students will spend three days on campus before New Student Orientation connecting with student leaders, getting familiar with campus resources and services, and learning strategies to successfully transition from high school to college. Transitions aims to provide a welcoming and supportive community for students. Activities and resources are provided with an emphasis on academic readiness, campus support, and social/cultural enrichment will be provided. Participants will be paired with a peer mentor that is assigned to them for the academic year.
