**May 2015**

**METHODOLOGY**

*Purple Insights conducted 952 telephone (landline & cell) interviews of New Hampshire likely 2016 general election voters, including oversamples of 2016 Republican and Democratic presidential primary voters, between May 2 and May 6, 2015. Respondents were randomly selected from a voter file.*

*Base sample:*

- 500 general election voters (MoE: +/- 4.4 percentage points, at the 95% confidence level)

*Base + Oversample:*

- 400 Republican primary voters (MoE: +/- 4.9 percentage points, at the 95% confidence level)
- 400 Democratic primary voters (MoE: +/- 4.9 percentage points, at the 95% confidence level)
